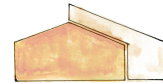

NOTES

(1) Costs: No application fee is required. All international participants are required to pay for food and accommodation at the weekly rate of 100€ by homestay plus 350€ as project contribution. The contribution will be used for funding the project (ie; material, tools, local labor...). A nonrefundable deposit of €100 will be requested from the participant to reserve your spot in the workshop.

(2) Liability: By signing this document, you are waiving the workshop leaders of all liability. This is a construction site in rural Africa, while we have done our very best to assure the safety of everyone involved, accidents and incidents may take place. The workshop leaders and community coordinator will assist in all ways possible should any incidents occur, however, we will not be held responsible or liable.

(3) Project Report (not required of volunteers and independent practitioners): At the end of the workshop, we require all student participants to collaborate with the Workshop Director to put together a Visual Report in PDF to document and publicize the results of your efforts in the workshop. For the documentary, we will need from you any text and visual information (such as sketches, drawings, process photos, or video clips) you generated during the entire experience from your arrival to departure moments.

(4) Course Credit: Nka Foundation will support students who have a specific research topic they wish to develop to earn college credit. However, the topic must be preapproved by Nka in advance of starting the research or internship course. The specific criteria necessary to earn credit will also need to be coordinated between Nka and the teacher involved. If this is the case, please provide necessary information and the school contact person who will coordinate your study abroad course.

(5) Schedule: We are flexible. However, it is expected to work 40 hours per week.

(6) Keep in Mind: Our project sites are rural locations, most precisely deep in the village in Abetenim where the convenience of development has not reached. Please plan and pack accordingly.
